

## Dublin Certificate in Evidence Based Joint Injection

This course is open to Registered General Nurses who have successfully completed an Advanced Health Assessment module.

### ABOUT

Through blended learning this module aims to:

- Provide evidence-based recommendations around the principles, practice, and techniques for joint and soft tissue injection therapies for people with rheumatic musculoskeletal disease (RMD)
- Prepare participants to expand their skills base with respect to the use of injection therapies for people with RMD
- Advise participants to work within their respective scope of practice when administering prescribed injection therapies
- Emphasise a person centred approach to healthcare delivery.
