Course: Care of the Person with Rheumatic Musculoskeletal Disease



Overview of the course

This course is for registered general nurses with at least one year's post-registration experience. Taught by rheumatology ANPs and CNSs, it is ideal for nurses who are currently working in rheumatology and is also a good starting point for nurses who are new to rheumatology.

Students may also participate in the HSE's Making Every Contact Count (MECC) workshop - a behaviour change programme aimed at the prevention and management of chronic disease.

This standalone module is also part of the Graduate Diploma in Chronic Illness Management and is delivered in partnership with UCD.
