1. The Promoter

2. Lottery Licence

The Promoter granted a lottery licence by the Dublin District Court on 25th February 2026 under section 28 of the Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1956 as amended by the new Gaming and Lotteries (Amendment) Act 2019.

The Raffle will run from 3rd March 2026 to 1st May 2026 (Closing Date) inclusive. All competition entries must be received by the Promoter no later than midnight on the Closing Date. Any tickets received after this date will be disqualified

3.2. To Enter
